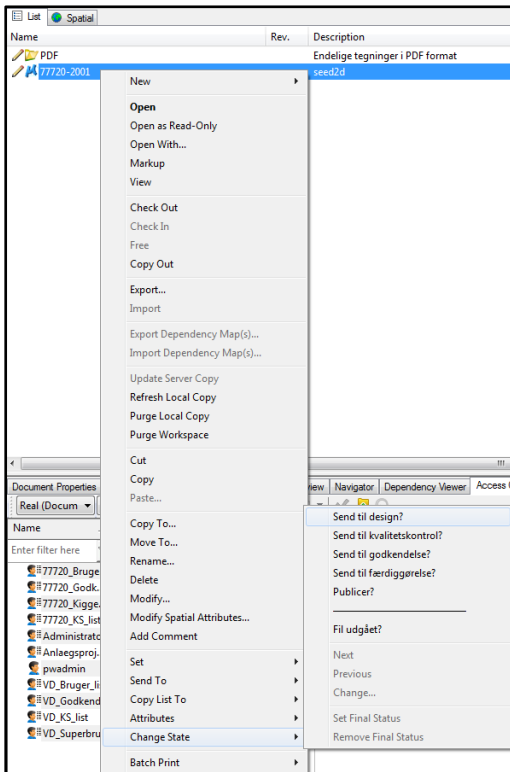




CAD-drawing – Revision

Revision of CAD-drawing in ProjectWise

When a CAD-drawing has to be revised, it has to be sent from the 'Published' state to the *Design* state.



Right-click on the drawing and select 'Change State'.

Now select 'For design'.

The CAD-drawing should now be at the design state, ready for revision.

Attributes for drawing:

Right-click on the drawing and select 'Properties'.

Select the 'Attributes' tab to fill in the following relevant attributes:

- **Revision:** To be completed with a letter when a revision is to be made of the CAD-drawing. Shall be filled in at the 'Design' state.

- **Revision text:** Write why a new revision of the CAD-drawing has been created. Shall be filled in when the file is at the 'Design' state.

- **Design.:** Fill in who has designed the content of the CAD-drawing revision. Shall be filled in at the 'Design' state.

- **Check:** Fill in who has performed control of the CAD-drawing. Is automatically filled in when the drawing is sent from the 'Quality Control' (KS) state to another state.

- **Appr.:** Fill in who has performed control of the CAD-drawing. Is automatically filled in when the drawing is sent from the 'Approval' state to the 'Published' state.
