

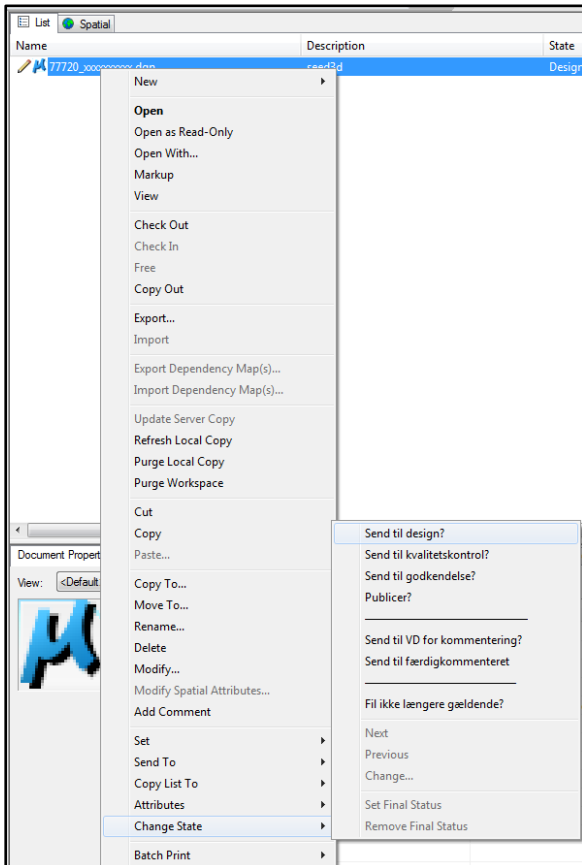


## Technical model – New version

### New version of a technical models in ProjectWise

If a new version of a technical model which is located on the 'Design' state is wanted, then you have to send it to the 'Preliminary' state and then send it back to the 'Design' state again. This causes a new version to be created and the original version is saved on the state 'Old version'.

If a technical model is located at the 'Published' state, it has to be sent to the 'Design' state. A new version is created, that can be updated or revised.



If the technical model is located on the 'Design' state, right-click it and choose 'Change State'.

Choose 'Preliminary'.

Again right-click the technical model and choose 'Change State'.

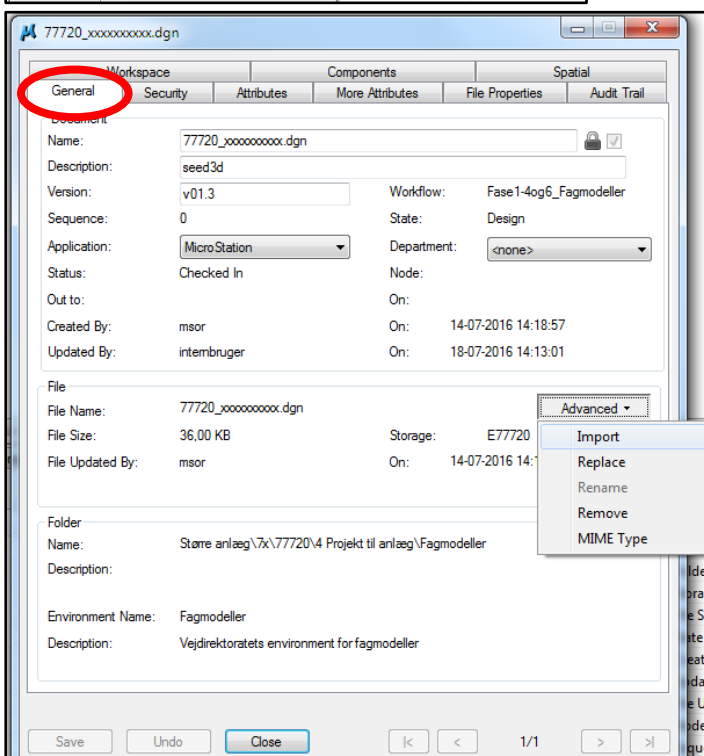
Now choose 'For design'.

The technical model should now be located at the 'Design' state, ready for a revision or an update.

If the technical model is located at the 'Published' state, right-click it and select 'Change State'.

Now select 'For design'.

The technical model should now be at the 'Design' state, ready to be revised or updated with a new file.



If the model is to be updated with a new file which is not in ProjectWise, right-click on the file and select 'Properties'.

Make sure that you are the 'General' tab.

Click on the button 'Advanced' and select 'Import'.

Now browse to the updated technical model and click 'Åben' (Open).

Click on the 'Save' and then 'Close'.

Remember to fill in the attributes for the updated technical model and send it to the next state.
